Right to receive information from the other conservator of the child concerning the health, education, and welfare of the child							
Right to confer with the other conservator to the extent possible before making a decision concerning the health, education, and welfare of the child							
Right of access to medical, dental, psychological, and educational records of the child							
Right to consult with a physician, dentist, or psychologist of the child							
Right to consult with school officials concerning the child's welfare and educational status, including school activities							
Right to attend school activities, including school lunches, performances, and field trips							
Right to be designated on the child's records as a person to be notified in case of an emergency							
Right to consent to medical, dental, and surgical treatment during an emergency involving an immediate danger to the health and safety of the child							
Right to manage the estate of the child to the extent the estate(s) has/have been created by the parent or the parent's family							
Duty to inform the other conservator of the child in a timely manner of significant information concerning the health, education, and welfare of the child							
Duty to inform the other conservator of the child if the conservator resides with for at least 30 days, marries, or intends to marry a person who the conservator knows is a registered sex offender under Chapter 62 of the Criminal Procedure or is currently charged with an offense which would require the person to register under that chapter							
Duty to inform the other conservator of the child if the conservator establishes a residence with a person the conservator knows is the subject of a final protective order sought by an individual other than the conservator, that is in effect on the date residence is established

Duty to inform the other conservator of the child if the conservator resides with, or allows unsupervised access to a child, by a person who is the subject of a final protective order sought by the conservator after the expiration of the 60-day period following the date the final protective order is issued							
Duty to inform the other conservator of the child if the conservator is the subject of a final protective order issued after the date of the order establishing conservatorship							
Duty of care, control, protection, and reasonable discipline of the child							
Duty to support the child, including providing the child with clothing, food, shelter, and medical and dental care not involving an invasive procedure							
Right to consent for the child to medical and dental care not involving an invasive procedure							
Right to direct the moral and religious training of the child							
Right to designate the primary residence of the child ___ without regard to geographic location ___ within _____							
Right to consent to medical, dental, and surgical treatment involving invasive procedures*							
Right to consent to psychiatric and psychological treatment*							
Right to receive and give receipt for periodic payments for the support of the child and hold or disburse the funds for the benefit of the child							
Right to represent the child in legal action and to make other decisions of substantial legal significance concerning the child							
Right to consent to marriage and enlistment in armed services							
Right to make decisions concerning the child's education*							
Right to services and earnings of the child, except as provided by section 264.0111 of the Texas Family Code							
Except when a guardian of the child's estate or a guardian or attorney ad litem has been appointed for the child, the right to act as an agent of the child in relation to the child's estate if the child's action is required by a state, the U.S., or a foreign government							
Right to apply for a passport for the child, renew the child's passport, and maintain possession of the child's passport							
Duty to manage the child's estate to the extent the estate has been created by community property or the joint property of the parents
